**Now, NH-44 under CCTV surveillance**

120 cameras installed at 20 locations from Kundli border to Ambala

**PANIPAT, APRIL 20**  
Five years after the announcement of Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar, the project of installation of CCTV cameras and automatic number plate readers (ANPR) at 20 locations on the 186 km stretch of the NH-44 from Kundli border to Ambala has been completed and a trial has been started. After a successful trial of

one month, it would be fully operational. The police would send e-challans to vehicle owners after it is fully operational. Sources say, in July 2016, the Haryana Police had planned to install CCTV cameras on the NH-44 and later in April 2017, the CM had announced installation of such cameras on the national highways across the state. In August 2019, the Haryana Police had finalised 20 locations, comprising three in Ambala,

four in Kurukshetra, six in Karnal, three in Panipat and four in Sonapat districts. As many as 120 CCTV cameras along with ANPR have been installed at 20 locations from Kundli border to Ambala on the NH, the IGP said. These cameras will be connected with the police control rooms in the district as well as the central control room, to be established in the IGP Traffic Office at Karnal, said an official. The authorities claimed that

these cameras would keep a check on speeding, reckless driving, and also help in identifying suspected vehicles. These cameras have been installed at black spots or accidental-prone zones on the highway, a police official said. The proposal of installation of CCTV cameras on other national highways like the NH-8 Delhi-Jaipur highway has been sent to the government for approval, the IGP said.

**Govt changed rules for hiring staff nurses, alleges Surjewala**

**CHANDIGARH, APRIL 20**  
Congress general secretary Randeep Singh Surjewala has accused the BJP-JJP government of changing the rules for the recruitment of staff nurses to attack the unemployed youth. He alleged the state's Department of Medical Education and Research conducted the examination for the recruitment of 307 staff nurses on Sunday, but it scrapped the essential condition of registering with the Haryana Nurses Registration Council. The registered candidates of any Regional Nursing Council or Indian Nursing Council have been allowed so that the youth from outside the state can also be selected.

It is noteworthy that in an advertisement, issued in 2019, only the candidates registered with the Haryana Nurses Registration Council were eligible to apply. Surjewala said when almost all states, including Uttar Pradesh, gives the opportunity to the registered candidates of the nursing council of their respective states to apply, then why was the Haryana Government, which has the highest unemployment in the country, discriminating against its youth. Asking a direct question to the Chief Minister, he said when the registered unemployed youth of the Haryana Nursing Council can't apply in other states, then the BJP-JJP government is anti-youth.

**Bogus call centre busted in G'gram**

14 arrested; 14 laptops, nine phones, ₹1.10 lakh cash seized

**GURUGRAM, APRIL 20**  
The Gurugram cybercrime police busted yet another fake call centre being run from a rented house in South City 1, Sector 51, and arrested 14 persons, including three women and four partners, here today. The police have also recovered 14 laptops, nine cell-phones and Rs 1,13,930 cash from the employees. This fake call centre, operational since March 1, has five partners. Posing as Microsoft employees, they were duping foreigners through pop-ups offering technical support, hardware upgrade and antivirus etc. Inspector Samer Singh of the cybercrime police station got a tip-off, following which

he along with the help of a Sector 40 police team raided the building this morning. They found 14 employees working on computers and laptops, a majority of them were busy making calls in English. The employees, however, didn't possess any valid OSP licence of the Department of Telecommunications or any other agreement/MoU related to their work. The arrested owners are Karan Sharma, Mayank Nath, Rahul Bhati and Mohit Bajaj, while the fifth partner, Rajat Juneja, was out of city. The other accused had been identified as Nikita, Simran,

Ankit Singh, Rahul, Mukesh, Lovish Sehgal, Priyal, Abhishek, Vishwas and Gurpreet Chawla, all residents of Delhi, said the police. Following the complaint of Inspector Samer, an FIR has been registered against the accused under Sections 419 and 120B of the IPC and Sections 66D and 75 of the Information Technology Act at the Sector 40 police station. "The accused trapped foreigners to clear pop-ups and provide antivirus in the name of technical help after posing as Microsoft employees. They asked the US nationals to purchase iTunes gift cards and then took their number and redeemed. We are conducting raids to nab the fifth partner and questioning the arrested accused," said Virender Vij, DCP (East).

**3 held in 86 cases of credit card fraud**

**FARIDABAD, APRIL 20**  
The district police have claimed to have busted a gang of cyber criminals with the arrest of three persons. The accused have been found to have been involved in 86 cases of credit card fraud. A spokesperson of the district police said the accused, identified as Gaurav, Abhishek and Pawan, all hailing from Delhi, had been arrested on the basis of the information collected by the cyber cell in response to a complaint by a local resident. The complainant Kavish, a resident of Sector 7, had told the police in February this year that he had been cheated of Rs 1.21 lakh by some persons who had offered to provide him credit card facility through company Bajaj Finserv in this sector. As the cyber cell of the police, which registered a case, succeeded to nab the accused on March 28 from their place, interrogation revealed that being the recovery agents of Kotak Mahindra Bank, they used to call the customers through a fake call centre and used to offer handsome discount for getting their present credit card replaced with a new one. After collecting all information, including the credit card statement and the OTP, the accused used to get money transferred to an account created on the website of a real estate company. A total 59 mobile phones were used in the crimes. — TNS

**Check safety of chemical storage in units: Dy CM**

**CHANDIGARH, APRIL 20**  
Deputy Chief Minister Dushyant Chautala has directed the officials concerned to check the safety measures related to fire and gas leakage in the chemical storage of all industries in the state. He directed them to prepare a standard operating procedure (SOP) in this regard. Dushyant said the industries should complete all formalities in the next 60 days. After that, surprise inspections would be conducted. The Deputy CM, who also holds the portfolio of the Industries and Commerce Department, was presiding over a meeting of senior officers of the Labour Department, the Department of Industries and Commerce and the Fire Services here on Wednesday. Dushyant, while expressing concern over the recent incident of the death of labourers in the fields in Hisar and Bhiwani, said the lives and goods of the poor, labourers, farmers and shopkeepers were important for the government. — TNS

**Wheat gutted, no relief for farmers**

No provision of compensation for burnt crops under PM's scheme

**ROHTAK, APRIL 20**  
The farmers whose wheat crop has been damaged in field fires are making rounds of government offices for compensation. The hapless farmers do not know whom to approach as there is no provision of compensation for the crops damaged by fire in the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY). "We have been requesting the authorities to make some provision for relief to farmers whose crop is destroyed in fire incidents, but to no avail," says Preet Singh, state vice-president and district president of the All-India Kisan Sabha (AIKS). The Kisan Sabha leader points out that the fire-affected farmers' requests for compensation from the state government's Revenue Department under the provision of relief for crop loss due to natural calamities are also being rejected.

Congress Rajya Sabha MP Deepender Singh Hooda has demanded that the provision of compensation for crops destroyed by fire should be included in the crop insurance scheme. "Why there is no provision of compensation for crops damaged by field fires is incomprehensible," says Deepender. The Rajya Sabha member has also demanded a bonus of Rs 500 per quintal for wheat-producing farmers


of Haryana in view of the substantial decline in the yield of wheat crop this year. He also urged the government agencies and authorities concerned to ensure prompt payment to farmers and provide some relief in the norms governing the quality of wheat grains. Meanwhile, independent MLA from Meham Balraj Singh Kundu has also demanded a bonus of Rs 500 per quintal for wheat-producing farmers

has been reaching out to the affected farmers of his constituency and providing compensation to them from his personal funds. "As the state government failed to provide relief to the fire-hit farmers, I decided to compensate them from my personal funds. I have provided compensation of Rs 10,000 per acre to the affected farmers for crop losses due to fire on more than 500 acres so far," says Kundu.

**Man gets life term for daughter's rape**

**SONEPAT, APRIL 20**  
The court of Additional District and Sessions Judge Surchi Atreja Singh on Wednesday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for raping his six-year-old daughter in the Kharkhoda area of the district. The court has also imposed a fine of Rs 51,000 on him, out of which Rs 50,000 would be given to the victim. The incident came to light in December 2019. A youth of Kharkhoda, in his complaint to the Child Protection Commission, said a woman had left her husband in Kharkhoda and their three children were living with their father. He further alleged that the father was physically abusing his daughter. — TNS
